Daddy is cooking.



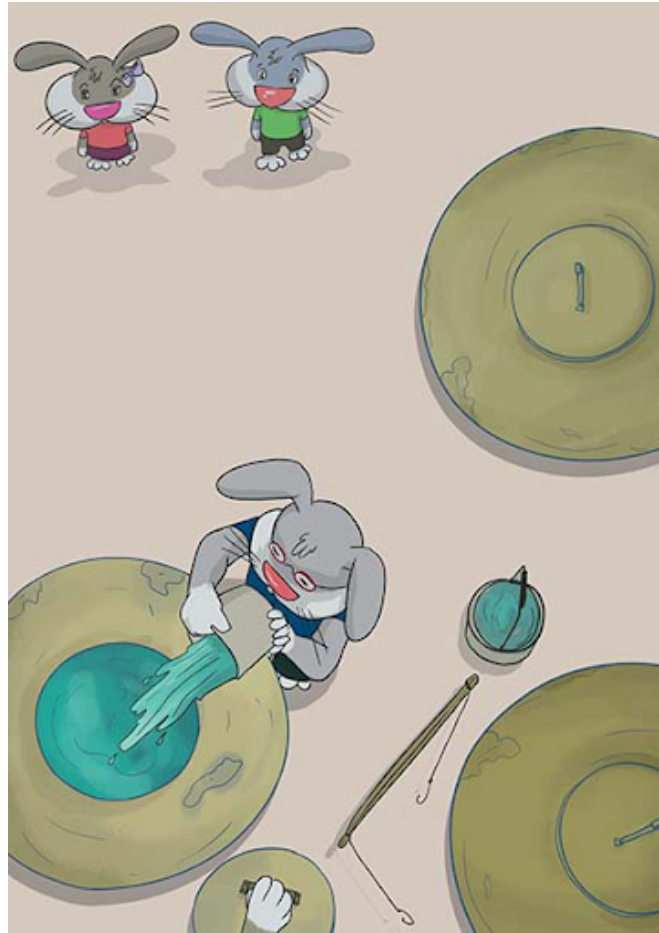
What is Daddy doing?

Daddy is ironing clothes.

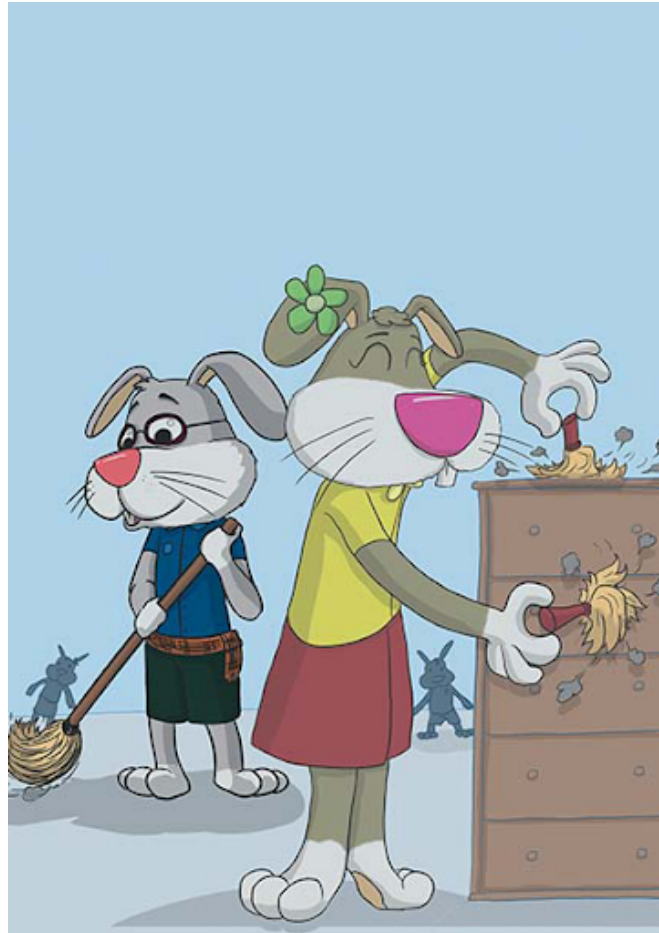


What is Daddy doing?

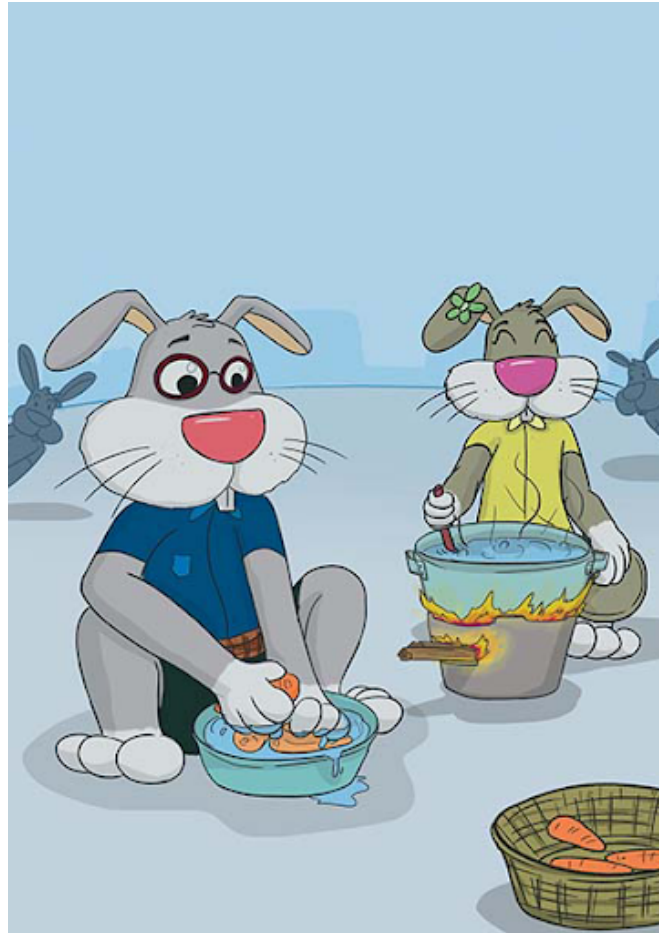
Daddy is carrying buckets of water to fill the large water jars.

Mommy is cooking with Daddy.



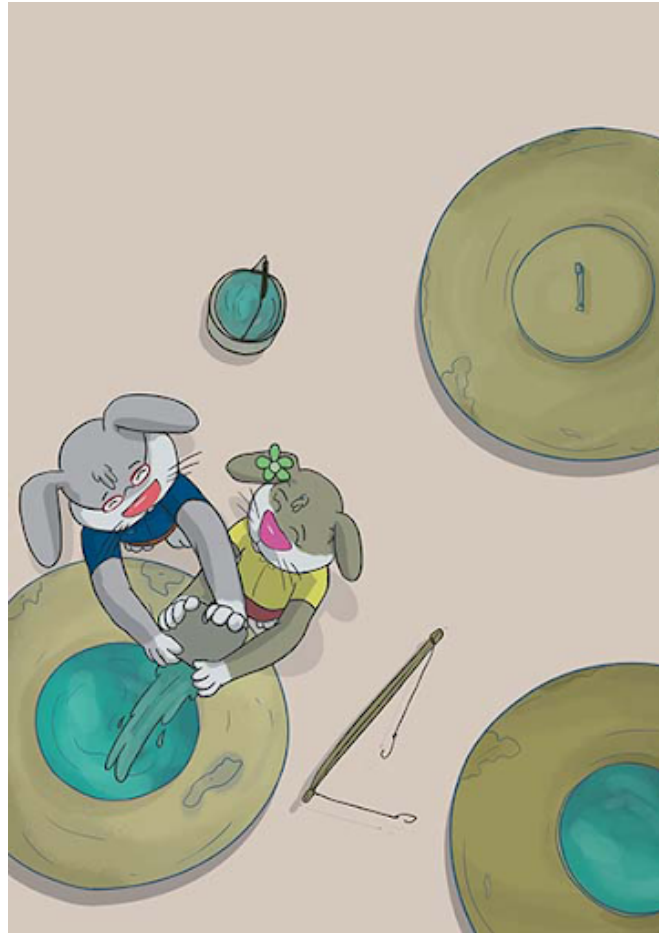
What is Mommy doing?

Mommy is washing clothes with Daddy.



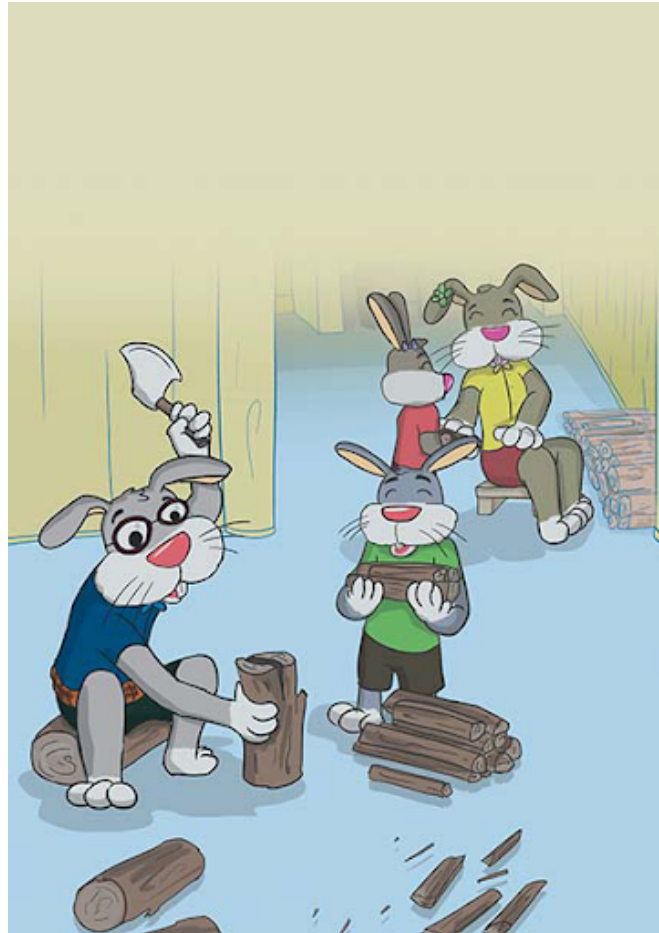
What is Mommy doing?
